

# **ATTENTION GLOVER GARDENS RESIDENTS** **TENANT COUNCIL ELECTION NOTICE**

The Lackawanna Municipal Housing Authority will conduct an election for a new Glover Gardens Tenant Council.

In accordance with previous by-laws, five (5) tenant representative positions of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Sergeant at Arms will be elected by the residents of the Glover Gardens to the Glover Gardens Tenant Council for a three year term. The election will be held on **Thursday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024** at the Glover Gardens Office from **9:00am – 5:00pm**

It is important to note that you **NEED NOT BE A REGISTERED VOTER WITH THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO VOTE IN THIS TENANT ELECTION**. However, it is important that you are at least eighteen (18) years of age AND a resident of the Authority at Glover Gardens for at least 30 days who is specifically named on a lease with the Lackawanna Municipal Housing Authority.

Residents who are eligible to run in the election for the five (5) positions of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Sergeant at Arms for the Glover Gardens Tenant council may pick up nominating petitions and affidavits at the Main office of the Authority located at 135 Odell Street, Lackawanna, New York 14218 beginning Thursday, July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024. If you are unable to come to the Main Office, you should call the LMHA at 716-823-2551, and arrangements will be made to have a nominating petition dropped off to you.

A tenant seeking a tenant council position must be in good standing. Good standing means there are no violations of their lease agreement with the Lackawanna Municipal Housing Authority. There are no debts owed to the Lackawanna Municipal Housing Authority and they are not involved in any litigation with the Lackawanna Municipal Housing Authority.

Residents wishing to pick up nominating petitions and affidavits may do so between the hours of 8:30am and 3:00pm Monday through Friday. The office will be closed during lunch between the hours of 12:00 Noon and 1:00pm. **Petitions will be due no later than 3:00PM, Monday, August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024** and shall be presented to the Lackawanna Municipal Housing Authority office, 135 Odell Street, Lackawanna, NY. The petitions will be time stamped by an office employee and a copy returned to the candidate. Again, if you are unable to drop off the petitions, arrangements will be made to have them picked up from you in person.
